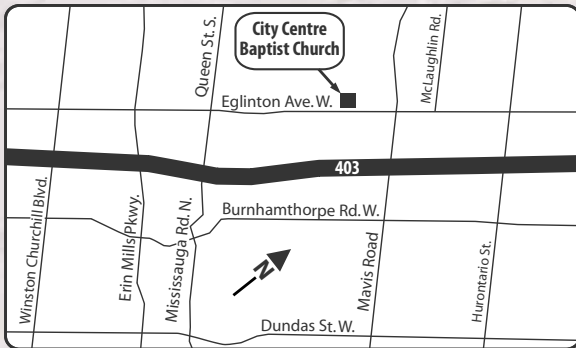

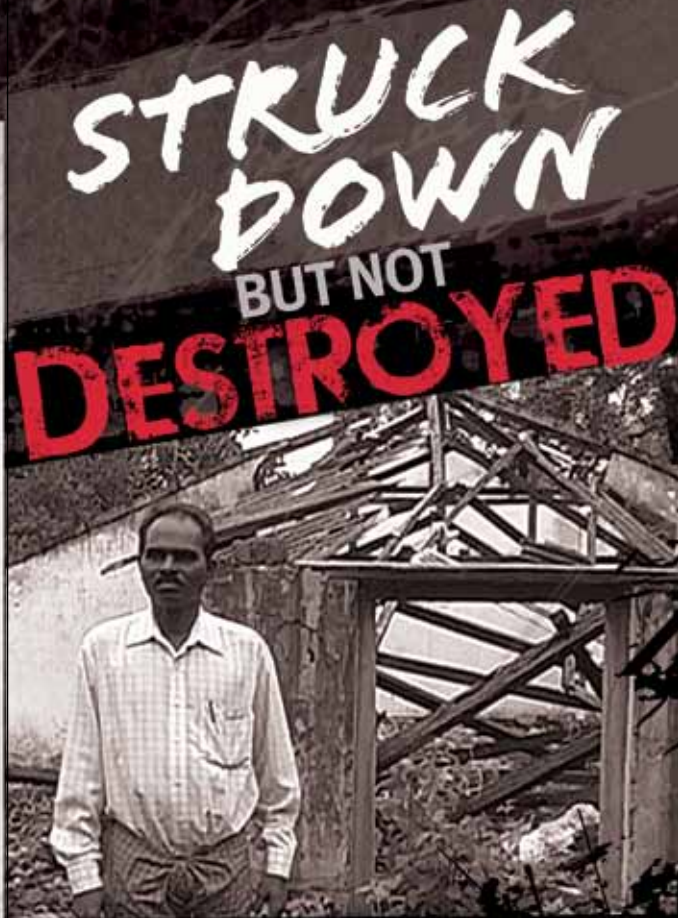
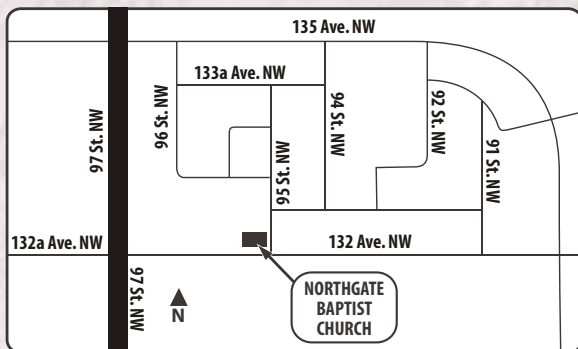

Getaneh M. Getaneh –

Getaneh knows firsthand what it means to be persecuted for being a Christian. He was arrested by communist authorities in Ethiopia in the early 1990s for preaching about Christ and was repeatedly tortured during his years in prison. He eventually escaped and fled to neighbouring Djibouti. When he returned to Ethiopia after the communist government fell, he was re-arrested and charged with converting Muslims to Christianity. Upon escaping a second time, he fled to the United States where he currently resides.

Rev. Sudhakar Mondithoka –

Rev. Mondithoka, the Director of the Hyderabad Institute of Theology and Apologetics and partner with The Voice of the Martyrs, works with and for the persecuted church in Orissa state and other parts of India. He has a passion to equip, help and encourage Christians who are facing persecution and strengthen the Body of Christ in his country. He is also a visiting professor and teaches in three seminaries and does much evangelistic speaking in universities, colleges, and among professionals.

Corey Odden –

Corey Odden became VOMC's Chief Executive Officer in early 2010 after serving as Vice-president of the Evangelical Council for Financial Accountability. Prior to that, he served as the Chief Financial Officer with The Voice of the Martyrs in the United States for 10 years during which time he travelled to 16 foreign countries in Europe, the Middle East and Asia.

Keith Kitchen –

Keith Kitchen is a gifted songwriter and communicator from Swift Current, Saskatchewan. He artfully combines deep biblical truth with moving tapestries of music. Keith will bless us with his music and lead us in worship at the conferences this year. Last summer, Keith recorded his first full-production album. Keith is also an Ambassador with VOMC's Volunteer Network and shares about the Persecuted Church in his concerts.

Floyd Brobbel –

Floyd Brobbel, VOMC's Chief Operations Officer, travels worldwide to meet with persecuted Christians on behalf of the mission. He helps set up and ensure the success of VOMC's many projects that empower the persecuted church. Floyd will be sharing what God is doing through the support of Christians in Canada to advance God's Kingdom in some of the most hostile places for followers of Christ in the world.

Greg Musselman –

Greg Musselman, VOMC's Chief Communications Officer (Multimedia Productions), has travelled extensively to interview persecuted Christians and produce video documentaries for the mission. A popular speaker, Greg also ministers to churches across Canada.
